

## **October 9, 2017 Meeting Summary**

Minutes for September approved

Discussion centered on the status of Mill Pond and Water Mill watershed:

- the pending storm water remediation plan developed by Alex Gregor and Christine Fetten;
- the history of past attempts at remediation (SolarBees, Phoslock).

The three attending candidates for Trustees presented their perspective on the need for a master plan for using available CPF water quality funds: concentrating on fixing waterfront communities one at a time with cluster septic systems rather than individual residential systems; plans to maintain (clean) all storm water drains, not only those drains that affect traffic; large-scale employment of oysters to filter the bays.

Notice was made that the DiMenna property is supposed to maintain tall grass outside the polo field to catch water and silt, but that this apron has been mowed tight to the ground. The Town Board should intercede.
